ES 304 - American Indian Oral Literature Units: 3 ; G.E./G.R. Area: UD-C; Diversity
UD-D; Social Justice

ES 307 - God is Red: American Indian Worldview Units: 3 ; G.E./G.R. Area: UD-C; Sustainability
ES 308 - Cultures of Habitat Units: 3 ; G.E./G.R. Area: UD-B; Sustainability
ES 327 - Decolonize Your Diet Units: 3 ; G.E./G.R. Area: UD-D; Sustainability

Note: No changes to, or from, the credit/no credit pattern are permitted after the Grade Type Change period. There are no exceptions to this rule. Courses in a student's major department, regardless of course prefix, may not be taken "CR/NC," unless that is the only grading pattern in the course.
