<input type="checkbox"/> Minimum 2.00 GPA for all attempted units at CSUEB	
<input type="checkbox"/> Minimum 2.00 GPA for all attempted units in the major	
<b>Unit Requirements</b>	
<input type="checkbox"/> Minimum 120 total semester units	
<input type="checkbox"/> Minimum 40 semester units as upper division (includes 9 units upper division GE)	
<input type="checkbox"/> Minimum 30 semester units in residence at CSUEB, including 12 units minimum of upper division courses in the major and 9 units min. of upper division GE (upper division GE may be taken at any CSU campus)	
<input type="checkbox"/> Minimum 48 semester units of GE (see above)

\*\* All upper division GE courses require the completion of A1, A2, A3, and B4 with C- (CR) or better. Junior standing with at least 60 earned units is highly recommended.
