ES 305 - Reel Injun: American Indians in Film Units: 3 ; G.E./G.R. Area: UD-Area 4; Social Justice	
ES 306 - American Indian Liberation Units: 3 ; G.E./G.R. Area: UD-Area 4; Social Justice	
ES 307 - God is Red: American Indian Worldview Units: 3 ; G.E./G.R. Area: UD-Area 3; Sustainability	
ES 308 - Cultures of Habitat Units: 3 ; G.E./G.R. Area: UD-Area 5; Sustainability	
ES 327 - Decolonize Your Diet Units: 3 ; G.E./G.R. Area: UD-Area 4; Sustainability
